VBA Project

The VBA Project Curriculum is part of the products to be produced under the Extension Support Program's Village Based Advisors project in LDRI's Evidence Informed Decision Making Practice.

The official title of the project is "Building the capacity of County Governments in Kiambu and Embu counties to implement a private sector-led Extension approach to improve food security of small-holder farmers" (hereinafter referred to as 'the VBA Project'). County governments are therefore key actors in this project due to their role in ensuring food security of smallholder farmers is secured.
